### **Requirements for the materials for publication**

1. Issuance: the text of the article shouldn't contain schemes and tables.
2. Initials and last name of the author are given with the alignment to the left in bold type, size 14.
3. The full name of organization and town are stated on the 2<sup>nd</sup> line (alignment to the right, in bold type, size 14.
4. The title of the article is typed in capital letters in Russian with the alignment to the centre in bold type.
5. There should be a blank space between the titles of the article in Russian and English.
6. The title of the article in English is typed in italics, size 14, and alignment to the centre. Annotation of the article is in Russian and English, in Times New Roman type, size 14, justified alignment. There should be a blank space between the titles of the article in English and annotation in English.
7. Parameters of body-type: Times New Roman type, size 14. Parameters of the paragraph: interline interval – 1,5; margins: left, right, upper, down – 2 sm; indent of a new paragraph-1,25 sm; alignment to the centre, pages are not numbered.
8. Footnotes in Arab numeration are placed on the last page of the article in Times New Roman type, size 10, width alignment.

**THE KURIL ISLANDS IN RUSSIAN LITERATURE OF THE XVIII-  
XX CENTURIES**

Different periods of the formation of the image of the Kuril Islands in Russian Imperial and Soviet literatures are described in the article. The author covers detailed depiction in fiction and science fiction texts as well as the very first episodic mentioning of Far East in Russian Literature including the diaries of Russian Missionaries abroad. From the XIX century the theme of the Kuril Islands in Russian literature dedicated to Far East has become dominant and continual in fiction and feature narrations.
